GROWING THE FUTURE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



OPENING OUR DOORS


AT 67 COLUMBUS ROAD IN ATHENS, OHIO

Family Membership with EBT or WIC card: \$25

With an EBT or WIC card, **all benefits** of the Annual Family Membership.

Duo Membership: \$75

Unlimited general admission during regular public open hours for **one named adult and one named child or two adults**, invitations to members-only events and previews, subscription to our e-newsletter and email updates, and 2 one-time-use guest passes.

Family PLUS Membership: \$150

All of the benefits of the annual family membership plus 2 additional one-time-use guest passes, unlimited admission for one additional adult caregiver to accompany children (e.g. sitter, grandparent), AND 50% off admission at participating museums of the Association of Children's Museums Reciprocal Network for up to 6 people (check with the museum before scheduling a visit.)
